INSTITUTIONAL DISTINCTIVENESS

The College places great emphasis on maintaining a **fair and transparent examination system** under the guidance of the **Examination Committee**. The primary objective is to conduct assessments **free from external influence** and uphold academic integrity. To achieve this, several measures are implemented:

- A systematic seating arrangement ensures that no two students appearing for the same paper sit at the same desk, with sufficient spacing between desks to prevent any form of malpractice.
- A double invigilation system is enforced, involving both invigilators and supervising invigilators to strengthen monitoring during examinations.
- A **flying squad**, consisting of two senior faculty members, conducts **random inspections** to detect and prevent any unfair practices.
- The **Standing Unfair Means Committee** investigates cases of **academic misconduct**. If a student is caught copying, they are required to **bring their parent** before the case is reviewed. Without parental involvement, the committee does not consider the case.

Through the **strict implementation** of these examination protocols, the College has successfully **curbed unfair means**, ensuring a **credible and ethical assessment process**.
